Understanding the Issues Some of the environmental regulations that are most likely to affect Federal and commercial projects include:

- Clean Water Act (CWA)
- Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA)

- Hazardous and Solid Waste amendments (HSWA)
- Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA)
- Executive Order 13101, *Greening the Government Through Waste Prevention, Recycling, and Federal Acquisition*
- Other state and local requirements.

Meeting all the requirements at a facility requires good planning and facility design, adequate staffing, and constant follow-up. Management programs such as the ISO 14000 Environmental Management System are often implemented to ensure compliance.

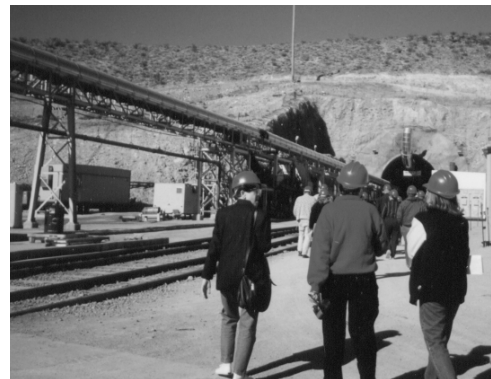
documents (including environmental assessments and environmental impact statements), and baseline inventories. Jason also provides highly skilled public involvement resources.
